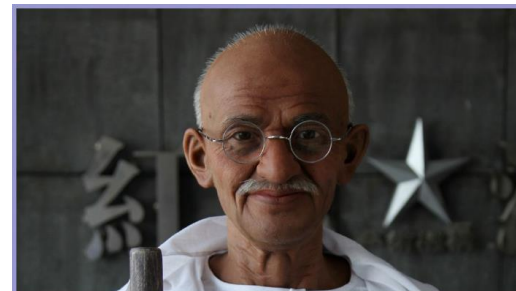

**Mohandas 'Mahatma' Gandhi** was a leader of India's independence movement, who led **peaceful protests**. At the time when India was led by Great Britain, **Gandhi** used **non-violent methods** to object to the **British rules** that he felt were unfair. His efforts earned him the title **Mahatma** which means 'great soul'.

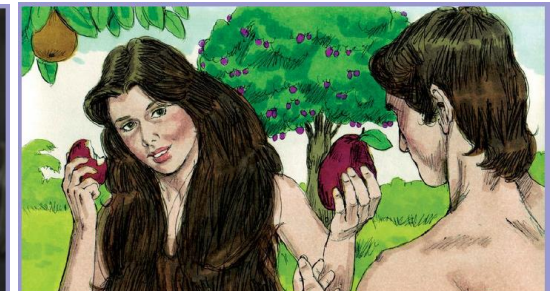


Mohandas 'Mahatma' Gandhi
